On September 30, 2020 you reported to Lapeer High School that you were experiencing some of the symptoms of COVID-19. This memo will serve as notice that you are required to remain off of school property until all of the following have occurred:

- A) At least 24 hours with no fever, without the use of fever-reducing medication;
- B) Improvement of symptoms related to sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, severe headache;
- C) 24 hours with no diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain
- D) If strep throat, do not return until at least 2 doses of antibiotic have been taken
- E) Negative COVID-19 test result

During your quarantine period, assignments and instructional content will continue to be posted in Google Classroom. You should continue your schoolwork in this remote setting until the end of your quarantine period. Contact your individual teachers if you require assistance.

Upon returning to school, you are reminded that you must continue to conduct daily self-screening prior to entering any LCS facility and you are prohibited from entering any school district facility if you display principal symptoms of COVID-19.
