- Special Education Teacher
- School Psychologist
- Other service providers, as appropriate

- Developmental Screening
- Medical History
- Developmental History

Our priority is helping children transition between home, school and their community.



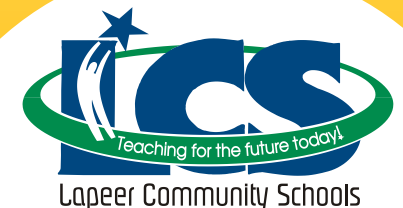
