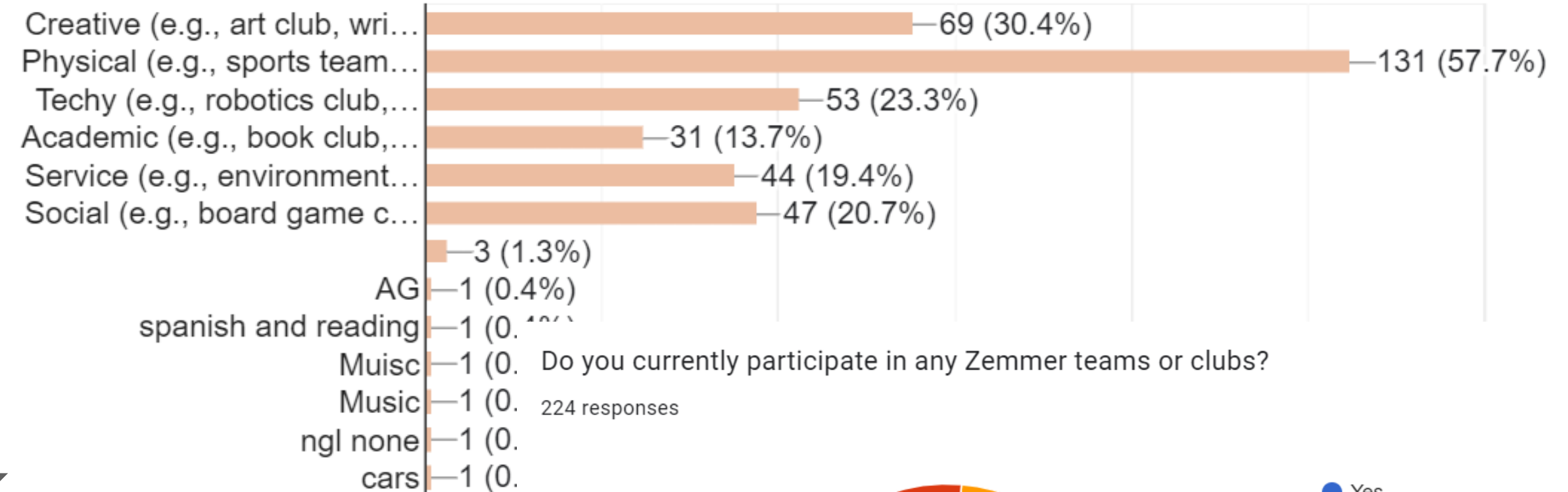

What types of activities are you most interested in? Check all that apply.

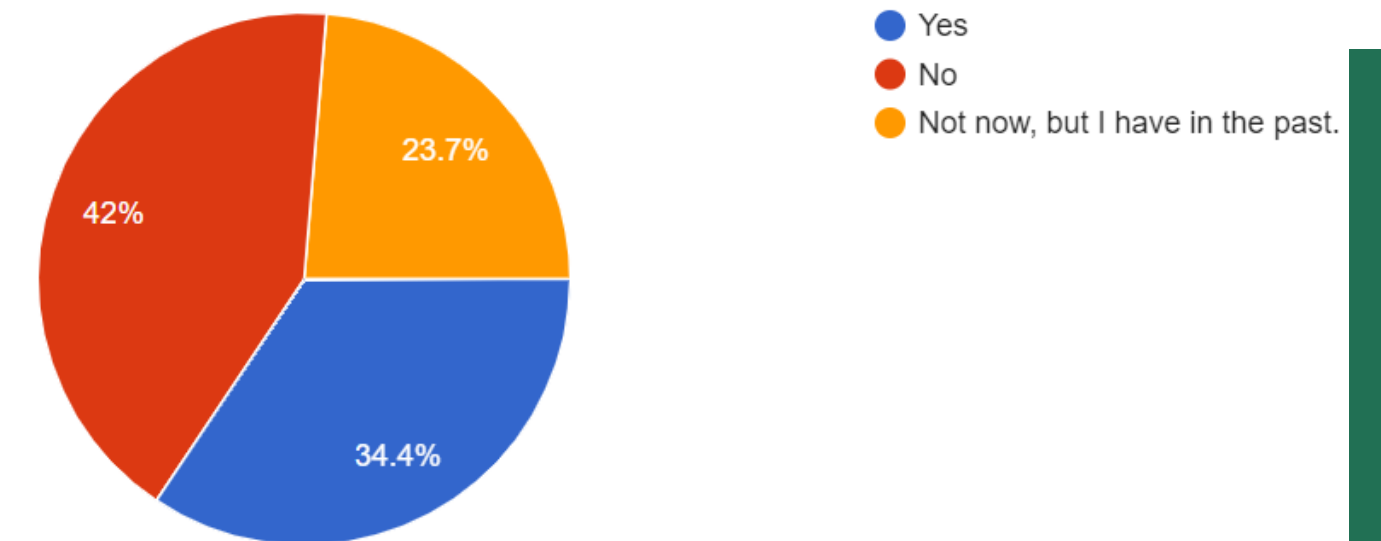

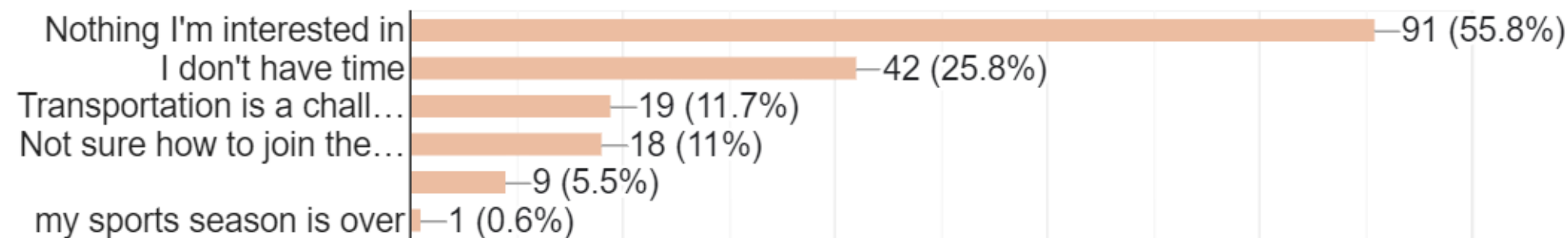
Do you currently participate in any Zemmer teams or clubs?

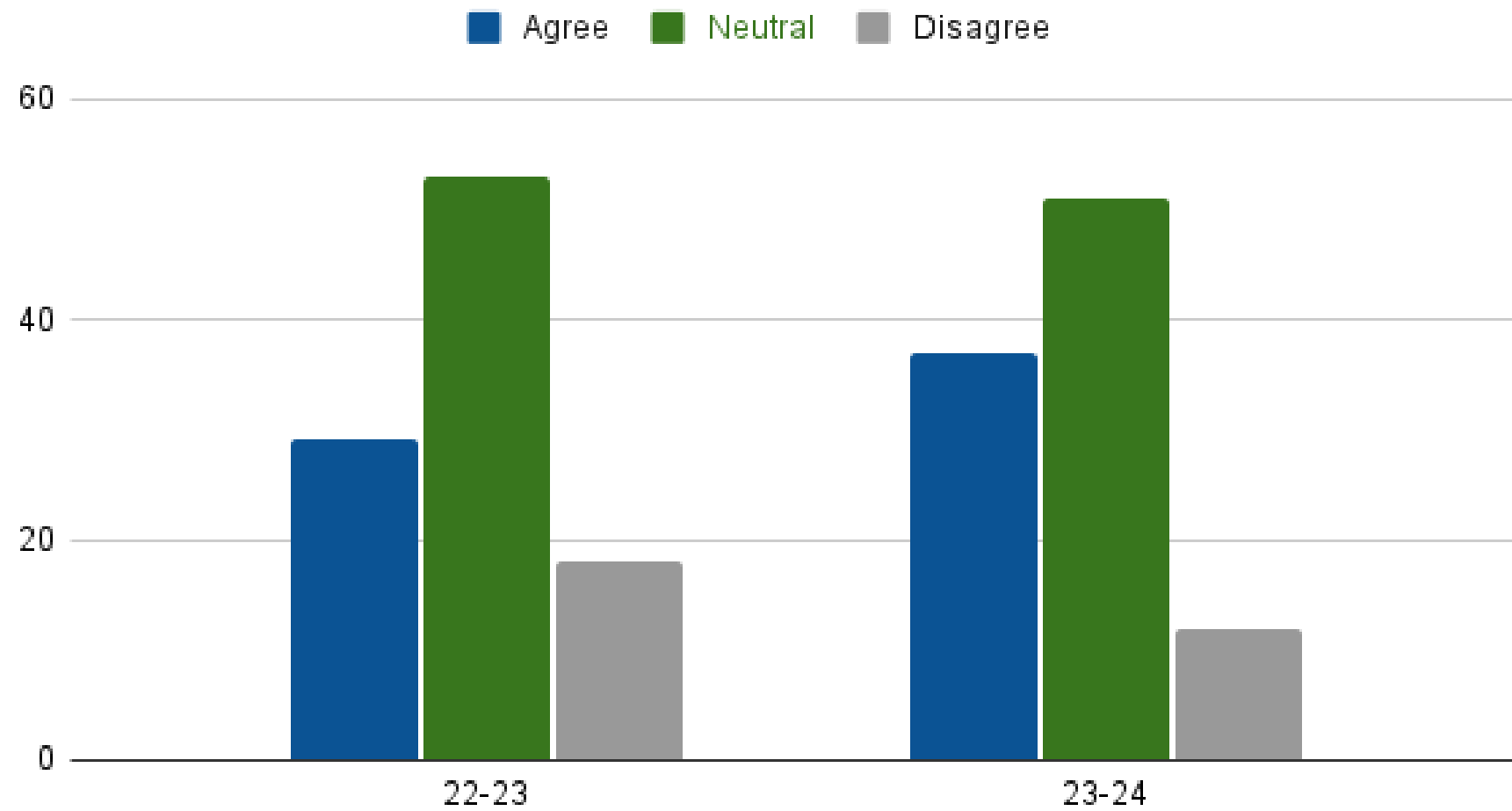

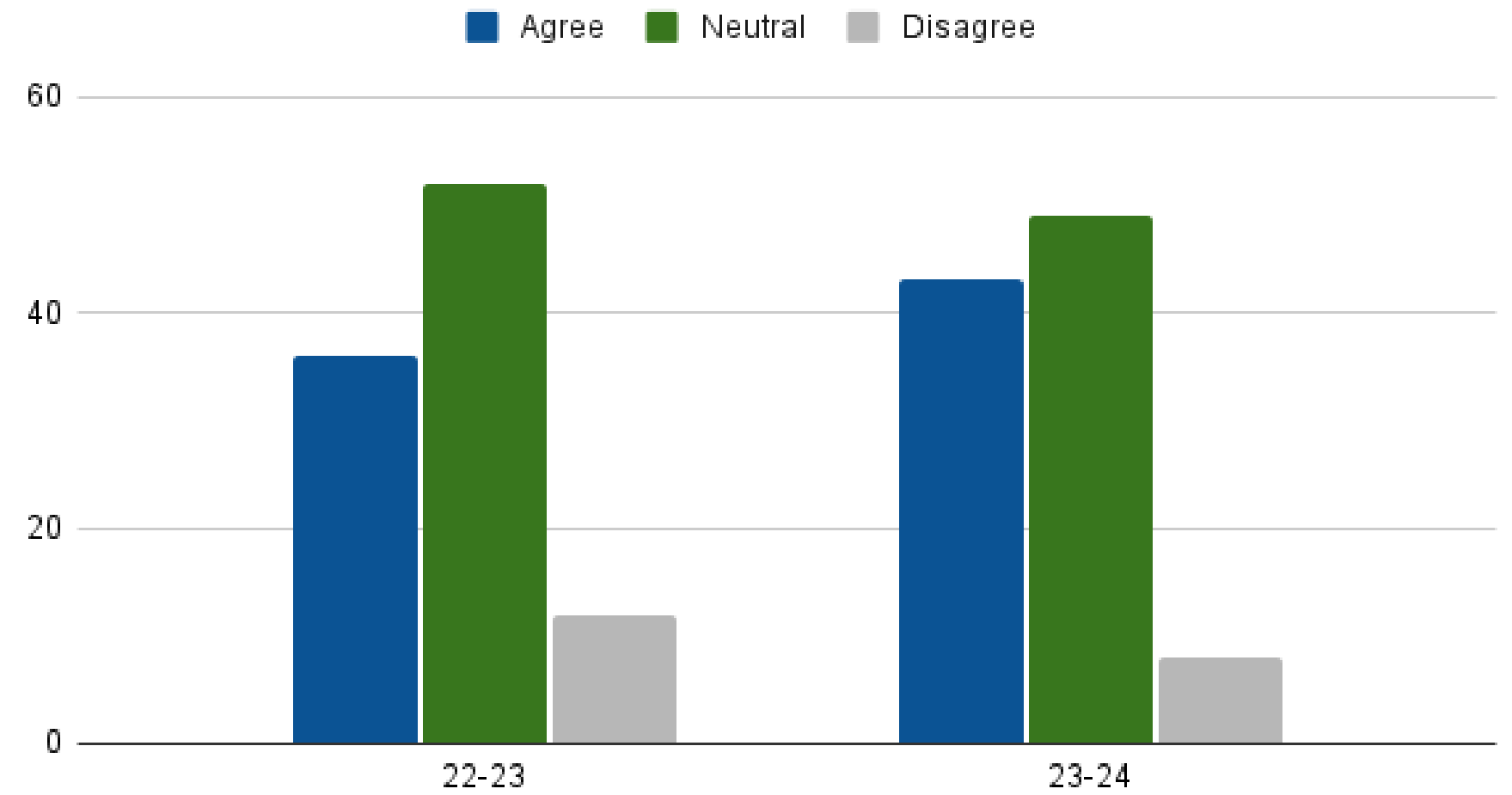
