Range: Up to \$5,000

Eligibility: 1) Junior or Senior 2) Must be a current student officer, rep of student council or class council 3) outstanding academic leadership activities 4) community school service 5) 300 word essay 6) take qualifying exam covering history, civics, economics and other social studies questions.

Deadline: Submit your name to be considered to Mr. Webster in the Counseling Office before October 1, 2009. (Only one name may be submitted from each high school in the country).
